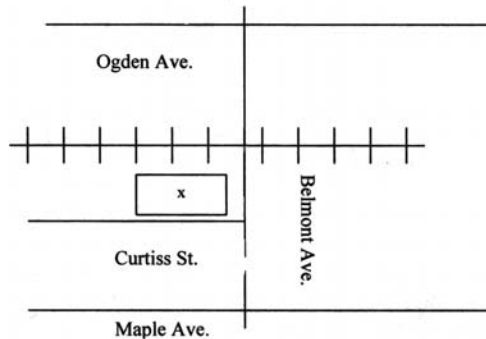

Poisons	Fluorescent Light Bulbs
Household Batteries	Car Batteries
Automotive Fluids	Asbestos
Mercury Thermometers	Expired/Leftover Medicines
