Fire, Police Open House Set For Saturday, October 13

Hinsdale, Ill. – The Village of Hinsdale Police and Fire Department’s Annual Open House will be held on Saturday, October 13, from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Village’s Fire and Police Departments, 121 Symonds Drive. The theme for this year’s Open House is “Look. Listen. Learn. Be aware. Fire can happen anywhere™,” which works to educate the public about basic but essential ways to quickly and safely escape a home fire.

Come join police officers and firefighters for an array of activities that the whole family can learn from and enjoy. Activities include demonstrations on various firefighting equipment, the fire safety trailer and interactive programs for children. The Fire Department will also conduct a simulated live burn to demonstrate the advantages of a residential sprinkler system. Police activities include a SWAT team demonstration, child fingerprinting, crime prevention programming, community notification tools, and specialized assignments and equipment within the Police Department. Police Department tours will also be conducted.

Additionally, the Fire Department has arranged for Fox Valley Fire and Safety to check fire extinguishers from your home or small business free of charge. Should the check indicate that service is necessary, representatives will be on hand to answer any questions or assist you further in making sure that your fire extinguisher is properly maintained and serviceable. There is a three fire extinguisher limit per person. Residents may purchase new extinguishers or have them serviced at this time.
