Chairman Keseric called the meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission to order at 5:30 p.m. on April 14, 2009 in Memorial Hall in the Memorial Building, 19 East Chicago Avenue, Hinsdale IL.

### Minutes

Chairman Keseric presented the minutes from the March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2009 meeting to the Commission and asked if they had any changes to the minutes up for approval. Commissioner Buczkowski motioned for the approval of the minutes as amended March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Commissioner Ives seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

### Discussion

#### **National Preservation Month**

Mr. Gascoigne provided the Commission with an update regarding Preservation Month and stated judging would take place this weekend. He discussed nominations for this year were lower when compared to previous years possibly due to less marketing from the newspapers. He indicated that awards and prizes for the coloring, photo, and preservation awards have been donated by a number of businesses and will distributed to the winners. Commissioner Arens provided an update regarding the photo contest. He stated that although the Village as of has received zero submittals as of tonight's meeting he was confident some schools he talked to should be submitting entries in the next week. The Commission discussed ways to better promote Preservation Month for the following year and the details of the awards ceremony for this year.

Commissioner Arens questioned if there were any candidates for filling the vacant spots in the Commission. Mr. Gascoigne stated that to his knowledge, none had been received to date but to forward any information such as resumes to the Village Manager who would than present this information to the Village President.
