- Windows will be judged on creativity. Entries will be divided into three age groups: 4- 5, 6-8 and 9-10. Prizes will be donated by local Hinsdale Businesses and the Hinsdale Historic Preservation Commission.
- Winners will be notified by telephone from the Village and awards will be presented during a Village Board meeting on **May 3rd**, 6:45 p.m. at the Memorial Building. Decisions of judges are final.
- All entries will be on display at Kramer Foods, as part of Historic Preservation Month
- Posters will also be available at the Village of Hinsdale and Kramer Foods. Only one entry per person.

This famous Hinsdale structure designed by Architect Edwin H. Clark of Chicago was built to memorialize the brave men who had given their lives defending this country. The style is a brick, colonial with Bedford stone trim and a portico supported by white wooden pillars. The original structure was built in 1927 with substantial additions being completed in 1929, 1969 and 1989.
