RE: 2017 Accelerated Road Program

Activity Type: Parking Restriction

Dear Resident,

The Village is continuing its construction activity in your neighborhood as part of the 2017 Accelerated Road Program. The Village's Accelerated Road Program is the Village's initiative to accelerate Village road improvements by 2020.

As construction activities progress from Zone to Zone (with a total of 8 Zones), the affected streets will be posted with "No Parking" signs. Initially, these parking restrictions will be effective Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. All residents should refrain from parking in the street at this time except for residents with driveway access restrictions (due to the curb replacement in front of their house). These residents will be allowed to park on the street away from construction activity. Access for these properties will be restored up to five days after the curb is poured. The contractor will provide temporary stone ramps to restore driveway access. Once all driveway access is restored, all street parking will be prohibited. Residents are asked to please advise all guest, delivery and service personnel of these parking restrictions.

More about the Village of Hinsdale's Accelerated Road Program

The Village of Hinsdale began implementing the Master Infrastructure Plan (MIP) in 2009. Since its inception, 25 of the Village's 66 miles of road have been improved. An additional 4.5 miles of road are scheduled to be improved in 2017, including the Central Business District. Combined, the proposed Accelerated Roadway and Infrastructure Plan include an additional 25.6 miles of road that will be improved by 2020.
