9-13-1: **ADOPTION OF FUEL GAS CODE:** There is hereby adopted by the village the international fuel gas code, 2000 edition, as hereinafter amended (hereinafter the "IFGC"). One copy of the IFGC has been on file in the office of the village clerk for a period of at least thirty (30) days prior to the adoption of these provisions and now is and remains on file in the office of the village clerk, and the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein. (Ord. O2001-57, 10-16-2001)

9-13-2: **APPLICATION:** The IFGC shall apply to all buildings and structures within the village to the extent that they are expressly regulated by the IFGC. (Ord. O2001-57, 10-16-2001)

9-13-3: **AMENDMENTS, REVISIONS, AND CHANGES:**

Section 403.4.3, Copper and Brass: Delete.

Section 403.4.4, Aluminum: Delete.

Section 403, Metallic Tubing: Delete only seamless copper and aluminum alloy tubing.

Section 403.5.2, Copper Tubing: Delete.

Section 404.9, Minimum burial depth, remove 12 inches (305 mm) and replace with 18 inches (457.5 mm).

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE VILLAGE CODE OF HINSDALE
REGARDING BUILDING REGULATIONS SAFETY CODES
