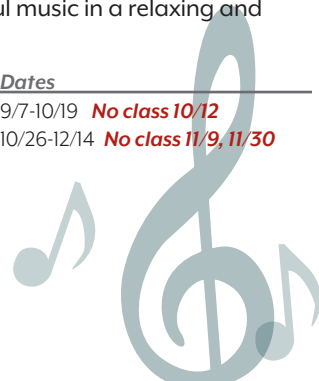

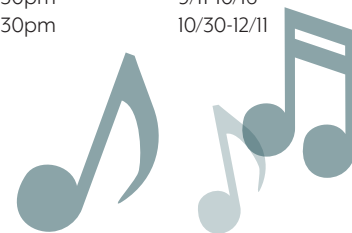


### Beginner Guitar
